# MSP MUGA AND TENNIS COURT COVID-19 MANAGEMENT

# IN LINE WITH CURRENT GOVERNMENT GUIDANCE - IF YOU ARE SYMPTOMATIC, LIVING IN A HOUSEHOLD WITH A POSSIBLE COVID-19 INFECTION OR IF YOU ARE CLASSIFIED AS EXTREMELY VULNERABLE ON HEALTH GROUNDS, YOU SHOULD REMAIN AT HOME AND FOLLOW GOVERNMENT GUIDANCE

- The MSP shall oversee and maintain the implementation of measures to ensure they reopen safely.
- All activity will be consistent with the government guidance regarding health, travel, social distancing and hygiene at all times
- We will consider safety first, particularly minimising the risk of infection/transmission. A thorough risk assessment has been undertaken, and appropriate measures put in place to ensure participants, staff and volunteers are protected
- Guidelines will be updated as we progress through the different phases of Government measures the LTA remains in discussions with Government and so we will check the official LTA position at www.lta.org.uk/coronavirus on a regular basis to stay abreast of the latest recommendations
- Any measures put in place to enable tennis activity to resume need to be capable of being flexed or changed quickly if tighter movement/social distancing is reintroduced in the future or when the restrictions are further relaxed

# FACILITIES

- The facility will be opened at 9.00 am and closed at 7.00 pm each day and the entrance gate left open for the duration
- The floodlights will not be in operation until notified otherwise
- 2 Outdoor courts will be opened with the centre court of the three remaining closed
- Toilet facilities will not be available at the MSP
- All other areas of the Pavilion remain closed
- Nets will be left at the appropriate height for adult tennis and we will remove net winders

# **HEALTH, SAFETY & HYGIENE**

- First aid equipment must be provided by the players, or the tennis club if it is a match
- Guidance on delivering first aid during the coronavirus pandemic is available on the St John Ambulance website
- Hand sanitizers and wipes should be brought to the courts by players where possible. It will not be provided on site
- All common touchpoint surfaces (gates, door handles, etc) will be regularly cleaned by MSP staff wearing disposable gloves

# **TENNIS ACTIVITY**

- Activities will be limited to court rental and coaching activity and to no more than two people per court (other than where players are from the same household)
- No extra-curricular or social activity should take place

#### **COURT ACCESS**

- We will ensure measures are in place to minimise encounters between people, including in car parks and at entrances
- Court gates should be left open during playing hours
- There is only one entry point but there will be markings of two metre distances at the entry gates to courts
- Please do not access the courts until the previous players have left

# EQUIPMENT

- Players should bring their own equipment it is advised to avoid use of communal rackets or tennis balls
- Use of coaching equipment (e.g. cones) should be limited, with any equipment used cleaned and wiped down afterwards
- There will be no communal MSP equipment available

#### **BOOKINGS & PAYMENT**

- Online bookings can be made as usual through ClubSpark
- One hour booking slots will be available
- Please do not arrive more than 5 minutes before your booked time and please leave the MSP facility within 5 minutes of finishing your booking
- On arrival please leave at least one parking space between your car and any other car parked in the car park

#### **SPECTATORS**

- Spectating is discouraged. Where attendance of a parent/guardian (non-participant) or a carer for a disabled player is required, it is limited to one per player where possible, with social distancing strictly observed while watching the sessions
- All spectators are to remain outside the courts unless dealing with an injury to the payer they are in attendance to look after

# COMPETITIONS

- The Tennis Club shall take responsibility for any club competitions
- There will be no organised MSP competitions until further notice
